The title pages of the other texts in the chest are shown here. These works, some classical and others less well known, have obviously supplied the content and inspiration for the books shown above and as exemplified by the selections shown here.



This is the only known portrait of Tristram Shmuk which is dated 2 yrs before he left for the colonies. According to the baptismal records in the church at Little Dunmow, Essex, the spelling of his surname here is the correct one, it appears to have been accidentally changed and misspelled on his arrival in Virginia. A smaller version of this woodcut appears on the title page of his son Theophrastus's "Alphabet". The quality of the work is very poor and the artist has pirated the design from "De Fabrica".

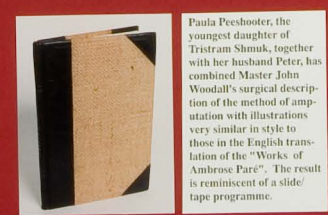

SHMUK Jnr - 1666



Theophrastus Shmuk, son of Tristram and a schoolteacher, produced this simple alphabet using the initials from the Fabrica of Vesalius. Through hardly a "medical" text it might qualify as a "pre-medical" book and would certainly have been learnt catechismally like many modern medical works.
