**Biographical sketch:**

John R. Martin (1922-1913), professor and rheumatologist, was born in Dublin, Ireland on April 11, 1922. He had his early schooling at the High School, Dublin, Ireland, then in Canada at Montreal West High School and Lower Canada College. He graduated from McGill University with a BSc in 1944 followed by an M.D., C.M. in 1945. His postgraduate work included: Junior Rotating Internship at Montreal General Hospital, 1945-1946; Rotating Intern at Queen Mary Veteran's Hospital, Montreal, 1946-1947; Student at the British Post Graduate Medical School, Hammersmith, west London, England, 1947-1948; Pathology, Royal Infirmary, Aberdeen, Scotland, 1948-1949; Assistant Resident in Medicine, Queen Mary Veteran's Hospital, 1949-1950; Assistant Resident in Medicine, Royal Victoria Hospital, Montreal, 1950-1951; Research Fellow, Clinical Investigation Unit, Queen Mary Veteran's Hospital, 1951-1952; Assistant Resident in Psychiatry, Queen Mary Veteran's Hospital, 1952-1953; Research Fellow, Canadian Arthritis and Rheumatism Society, Columbia Presbyterian Hospital, New York, USA, 1953-1954; and London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, England, combined course in Medical Statistics and Epidemiology, 1985-1986.

Dr. John Martin held several professional positions over the course of his career, beginning with Clinical Assistant Professor of Medicine at McGill University in Montreal, which he left in 1975 to accept a Professorship in Rheumatology at the new medical school at Memorial University in St. John's, Newfoundland. While at Memorial University, Dr. Martin was Professor of Medicine (Rheumatology), 1975-1990; Director, Northern Medicine and Health Program, 1978-1984; Professor of Occupational Medicine, 1987-1990; Associate, Memorial University of Newfoundland Centre for Offshore and Remote Medicine (MEDICOR), 1984-1991; History of Medicine Group, 1985-1990; Professor of Medicine (Rheumatology) (part-time), 1990, and professor of Community Medicine (Occupational Health), 1990-1991.

In addition to teaching responsibilities, Dr. Martin held other positions as well. He was Chief Occupational Medical Officer for the Province of Newfoundland from 1983 to 1991, and was president of the Newfoundland Medical Association from 1976 to 1977. He was a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians (London), the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and the American College of Physicians. Dr. Martin married Claire (nee Connor), daughter of Henry and Elizabeth Connor of Balinderry, County Armagh, Northern Ireland, and they had three children: Richard, Jennifer, and Christopher.

Dr. Martin died April 29, 2013 in Ottawa.

**Custodial history:**

Dr. Martin deposited his working papers concerning the biography of Leonard Miller with the Faculty of Medicine Founders' Archive on 29 February 2000, two years after publication. On completion of the research for the book concerning the Fluorspar Mines in St. Lawrence, related papers were deposited in the archives in 2009, and draft manuscripts in 2012.

**Scope and content:**

Fonds consists of Dr. Martin's correspondence, research notes, collected research material, and publication information relating to the writing and publication of *Leonard Albert Miller: Public Servant* (published in 1998), and *The Fluorspar Mines of Newfoundland: Their History and the Epidemic of Radiation Lung Cancer* (published in 2012). Series 1-4 relate to the Leonard Miller Biography and series 5-8 relate to the Fluorspar Mines. Fonds is composed of the following series:

**Arrangement:**

When the papers of Dr. John Martin arrived at the Faculty of Medicine Founders' Archive, there was some degree of order present. Files were clearly labeled and in alphabetical order. This formed the framework for further arrangement and description of the collection, with the original order of material being preserved as much as possible.

**Restrictions:**

There are no restrictions on access to or use of the material in this fonds. Users should be aware however that copyright regulations state that any copy of archival material is to be used solely for the purposes of **research** or **private study**, and that any use of copied material for any other purpose may require the authorization of the copyright owner of the work in question.
