Administrative history:

The Centre for Offshore and Remote Medicine (MEDICOR) was established within the Faculty of Medicine in September of 1982 with the mandate to carry out research and development projects related to all health aspects of offshore oil, marine, diving and space industries, as well as other industries involved with remote operations, environmental stresses or hazards.

There were three main components to the MEDICOR operation. The first was the hyperbaric chamber treatment facility. As the medical treatment branch of MEDICOR, it received patients requiring emergency treatment for diving accidents and with other conditions needing hyperbaric oxygen therapy. Patients from the Critical Care Program of the HealthCare Corporation were also treated on a regular basis as the need arises.

The second major aspect of MEDICOR was compressed gas testing and analysis. This encompassed a fee for service business provided to local industry, government and other agencies in need of periodic analysis of the purity of compressed breathing gases (for example, fire fighters, diving operations, etc.). This quick and cost effective operation was impeded in October of 2004, however, when the Provincial Government introduced new regulations on the testing of compressed gas samples, which stated that such tests must occur at a facility accredited for compressed gas testing by the Standards Council of Canada (SCC). Since MEDICOR, despite having all the necessary high-technology equipment and the experienced staff necessary, was not accredited, it saw its clients go outside Newfoundland for their gas testing needs, while the organization was unable to expand and take on new clients due to the new regulations. This launched a major effort by MEDICOR to have the facilities accredited, for which the projected total cost was \$40,000.

As a part of the Memorial University of Newfoundland, MEDICOR also played an integral role in the university's Ocean Studies Program. The Ocean Sciences Centre, located in Logy Bay, NL, is a cold ocean research facility operated in conjunction with Memorial University of Newfoundland. Its laboratories are used for research on the North Atlantic fishery, aquaculture, oceanography, ecology, behavior and physiology.

Prior to the establishment of MEDICOR in 1982, a group within the Faculty had expressed a growing interest in several aspects of offshore medicine for a number of years. Dr. A. Maxwell House, the director of MEDICOR within the Faculty of Medicine for the first five years, Dr. Henry J. Manson, and Dr. John R. Martin, among others, were all integral to the establishment of MEDICOR. They recognized the substantial need for an adequate hyperbaric medicine facility in the Newfoundland. It would have major users in a number of medical specialities, shore-based

industries and for recreational diving groups. At the time, there was facility at the Marine Sciences Research Laboratory, which was not designed to serve as a clinical resource.

Although significant developments in this field had been made in Nova Scotia, they could in no way meet the needs for Newfoundland. As such, a feasibility study was set up in the Fall of 1979 following meetings between interested parties in August after a serious diving accident. In this extensive study, three main areas in which such a chamber system could be used were identified. First, it could be used for training divers and emergency medical technicians or attendants and for the familiarization of oil rig medics with the basics of diving medicine. The chamber could also be used in the field of research. Topics of interest at the time included the development of technology for use in the hyperbaric environment, the effects of hyperbaric oxygen on various toxic substances, and the function of the human lung as a heat exchanger under hyperbaric conditions, to name a few. Finally, the chamber's utility was also considered with respect to the service roles it could potentially play.

It was determined that a hyperbaric chamber of this sort could provide hyperbaric oxygen therapy for a variety of medical illnesses and emergencies such as gas gangrene, arterial gas embolism, refractory osteomyelitis, compromised plastic surgical grafts, chronic diabetic ulcers, carbon monoxide poisoning, osteoradionecrosis, soft tissue injury, among other topics. It could also serve as a recompression facility for shore-based commercial diving activities and aid in the treatment of decompression sickness through hyperbaric oxygen therapy. The Feasibility Study concluded in 1981 and in the fall of that year the decision was made by the Faculty of Medicine and the General Hospital to proceed with hyperbaric medicine developments, its facilities to be located within, adjacent to, or near the Health Sciences Centre in St. John's. Funding, approximately 2.8 million, came from the CNOBP for facilities and equipment.

Since its inception, a major concern of MEDICOR's was the development of teaching and training programs related to offshore and remote health and safety. This resulted in a number of courses and programs directed at physicians, rig medics, nurses, and general offshore employees. The development of these programs was undertaken in collaboration with Memorial's Continuing Medical Education Office, the College of Fisheries, and affiliated hospitals. MEDICOR also provided consulting and advisory services to a variety of businesses, organizations and agencies such as: the Canada-Newfoundland Offshore Petroleum Board (CNOBP), the Canada Oil and Gas Lands Administration (COGLA), and Workplace Health, Safety and Compensation Commission (WHSCC), Department of Labour, OH&S Inspections, RCMP, and various privately-owned companies. Other services provided by the MEDICOR laboratory included private contract research and compressed breathing gas purity analysis.

Even in its early years of operation, MEDICOR was rapidly recognized on the national level for the excellence of its contributions to the fields of offshore and remote medicine. Some of MEDICOR's earliest accomplishments included, but are not limited to: the development of Rig Medics' Refresher Courses in 1983 and 1984, the first of their kind offered in Canada; studies of the factors governing heat loss or gain in the human airway and thermally protective insulated buoyant immersion garments; and an approximately \$200,000.00 funded major offshore health study for the Royal Commission on the Ocean Ranger Marine Disaster.

Ongoing research projects included developing methods for measuring gases in biological fluids such as the Gas Amount and Solubility Apparatus (G.A.S.), which was developed and patented by MEDICOR to be used for measuring toxic gases and vapours in blood and other body fluids, monitoring the onset of oxygen toxicity, and developing a new method to elucidate the uptake and distribution of inert gases in diving.

MEDICOR also had a close connection to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's (NASA's) Abort Support System, which existed should either one of NASA's Space Shuttles experience a major engine failure upon launch. For over half the launches, the space shuttle followed a path over or near the island of Newfoundland, thus if an emergency were to occur during the launching, a massive recovery operation would be set into motion in which the crew might have to undergo decompression therapy. MEDICOR's hyperbaric chamber was viewed by NASA as one of the finest decompression facilities in the world and could be used by the Shuttle Crew in the event of an emergency landing in Newfoundland.

In 2009 the Faculty of Medicine transferred the ownership of MEDICOR's hyperbaric unit to Eastern Health for \$2. According to the transfer agreement, the university may use the specialized equipment for research and educational purposes, while Eastern Health governs the clinical use and maintenance of the chamber itself. This transfer highlights the primary role of MEDICOR as a clinical service, the facility increasingly being used to treat patients suffering from a variety of medical conditions and illnesses. Memorial retains ownership of the MEDICOR premises and the right to use the chamber for academic and research purposes, however, it is subject to the obligations of Eastern Health to treat patients in need of hyperbaric oxygen therapy and other treatments.

Currently, the MEDICOR facilities occupy an area of approximately 432 square metres (4,800 square feet) within the Faculty of Medicine, which includes a laboratory, classroom and hyperbaric unit. The laboratory is equipped with mass spectrometry, gas chromatography, and physiological monitoring devices along with the related support equipment. Future plans include establishing laboratory facilities for identifying and studying environmentally hazardous substances.

The hyperbaric unit itself is approximately 67.5 square metres (750 square feet), consisting of 3 chambers interconnected with a "wet pot" (water-filled hyperbaric chamber) that simulate in-water deep diving. The unit is equipped for hyperbaric oxygen therapy and decompression therapy and research, with saturation diving capability of 304.8 metres (1,000 feet) of seawater equivalent.

Custodial history:

The *fonds* was held at the Centre for Offshore and Remote Medicine (MEDICOR) facilities in the Memorial University of Newfoundland Faculty of Medicine. Mr. Dale Decker donated the material to the Faculty of Medicine Founders' Archive in 2008.

The MEDICOR files were kept in the Centre for Offshore and Remote Medicine (MEDICOR) facilities at the Memorial University of Newfoundland Faculty of Medicine and were transferred to the Faculty of Medicine Founders' Archive in early 2008 in a deposit of 26 boxes.

Accruals:

An additional accrual of 5 boxes was deposited later in 2010.

Arrangement:

When the MEDICOR papers arrived at the Faculty of Medicine Founders' Archive, there was a small degree of order present. While some of the boxes had clearly defined themes, many others had no discernible order. Where there were clearly labelled files with original titles used in earlier office filing, the titles and order were maintained. The rest of the material had an order imposed on it.
