Biographical sketch:

Title:

Andrew David Bagby (1973-2001), doctor, was born on September 25, 1973 to David Franklin and Kathleen "Kate" Daphne Bagby (nee Barnard) in Sunnyvale, California, United States. His father was a former US Navy serviceman who also worked as a computer engineer. His mother is a British registered nurse and midwife who moved from Chatham, England to the United States. Bagby was not married at the time of his passing in 2001. He had one child, a son named Zachary Turner who passed away in 2003.

Bagby attended medical school at Memorial University in St. John's, Newfoundland and Labrador from 1997 to 2000. Upon completion of medical school, he returned to his native United States and began a surgical residency at the State University on New York Upstate Medical University at Syracuse, New York. In 2001, Dr. Bagby relocated to Latrobe, Pennsylvania to begin his residency at a family practice under the supervision of Dr. T. Clark Simpson.

Dr. Bagby met Shirley Turner, a fellow medical school student at Memorial University, in 2000. Turner was also from the United States. The pair began a relationship that quickly turned tumultuous and tragic. Bagby attempted to move on, away from Dr. Turner, while practicing in Pennsylvania. Dr. Bagby was the victim of relentless harassment by Dr. Turner. In 2001, Dr. Bagby found out that Dr. Turner was pregnant with his son. On November 5, 2001, Dr. Shirley Turner in Latrobe, Pennsylvania murdered Dr. Bagby. After Dr. Bagby's muder, his parents David and Kate Bagby became embroiled in court proceedings to extradite Dr. Shirley Turner back to Canada for the murder of their son.

In July 2002, Dr. Bagby's son, Zachary Turner was born. His parents faced a difficult and trying process to visit with their grandson. In August 2003, Dr. Shirley Turner and her son, Zachary's bodies were found on a beach in Conception Bay, NL, both victims of a murder-suicide. After the death of their grandson, Dr. Andrew Bagby's parents fought to pass a bill to strengthen Canada's bail requirements for serious crimes. On December 16, 2010, Bill-C-464 "Zachary's Bill" was passed.

Since the passing of Dr. Bagby, his parents became activists. David Bagby wrote a book in 2007 titled *Dance with the Devil: A Memoir of Murder and Loss*, pertaining to his son's murder case.

Two scholarships were established in tribute to Dr. Andrew Bagby and his son, Zachary. *The Dr. Andrew David Bagby Family Medicine Scholarship* was set up for medical students at Excela Health Latrobe Hospital studying family medicine. *The DR. Andrew Bagby and son Zachary*

Bursary Fund was established to support students at the Memorial University of Newfoundland medical school.

Dr. Andrew David Bagby passed away on November 5, 2001 at the age of 28 years.

Custodial history:

Photographs taken by Dr. Andrew Bagby during his time living in St. John's, Newfoundland and Labrador were held by his parents, David and Kate Bagby prior to being donated to the Faculty of Medicine Founders' Archive, Memorial University.
