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**Title:** Health Sciences Centre fonds  
**Dates:** 1959-1995, predominant 1969-1978  
**Extent:** 60 cm of textual material, 263 photographs and 260 negatives

### **Biographical sketch:**

The first home of the Medical School was in the General Hospital, which was located on Forest Road in the east end of St. John's, and in Memorial University's Education Building on campus. Next, Temporary Buildings were built on campus to house the Faculty of Medicine (and other university units) until a permanent facility was constructed.

The Medical School and University Hospital project was first considered in the period 1961-1963, and its need and feasibility was supported by Lord Brain in his study and subsequent report on the Health Services in the Province in 1965-1966. The University, in recognizing the close disciplinary relationships between the Health and Life Sciences and the academic and economic benefits, which would be achieved, decided in 1967 to integrate the Life and Health Sciences into one physical and administrative complex. The facilities in this complex would include schools of the health-related professions in a similar close association to the continuing benefit of Newfoundland and Labrador.

In February 1968 a report entitled "St. John's and the Avalon Peninsula - Future Integration of Hospital Services" was submitted to the Department of Health. Combined in this report, at the specific request of the minister, were recommendations for the future role of the St. John's General Hospital in the region and for a phased upgrading of the hospital.

By 1971, funding had been confirmed through the Federal Health Resources Fund. Scrivener Products Limited (Toronto) was then selected to manage the project and coordinate the development of the facility, working closely with the St. John's based firm Project Management and Design Limited.

Despite the fact that planning and movement had begun on the new 400 bed hospital, it was clear that several years would elapse before the new facilities would become available. In the meantime, the General Hospital was intended to maintain essential services to the community and to continue its role in graduate medical education. Pending completion of the new hospital, the "General", as it was commonly known, was to participate in undergraduate clinical teaching with the likelihood of maintaining this participation, relative to its later role in the region, as an affiliated teaching hospital.

The first steel of the Health Sciences Centre was erected on Aug. 9, 1972, and the first concrete was poured Oct. 24, 1972. Just under 12 months later the last piece of steel was laid on Oct. 5, 1973. Although the building was not yet completed, the Medical School Faculty Council held a meeting in the Main Auditorium on 18 Dec. 1973. There are also photographs that were taken in North Sydney at the time of the C.N. strike in August, 1973. Several trailers, carrying equipment for the Health Sciences Complex, were stranded there for a week. Strikes slowed progress on

more than one occasion.

The Faculty of Medicine moved into the building in 1974 and the General Hospital moved into the HSC in the spring of 1978. The Honourable Frank D. Moores, then Premier of Newfoundland and Labrador, officially opened the facility on October 26, 1978. The former General hospital on Forest Road was renamed The Dr. Leonard A. Miller Centre in that same year.

**Custodial history:**

The papers were transferred to the archive when the Lillian Stevenson Nursing Archives and Museum (LSNAM) closed down its archival collection in 2011. Papers that related to the creation of the Health Sciences Complex were transferred to the Faculty of Medicine Founders' Archive. The papers in this collection represent what was kept by planning and executive committees who were based at the Forest Road facility, the former General Hospital.

**Scope and content:**

The papers in this fonds relate to the planning and construction of the Health Sciences Complex. As these papers were maintained at the former General Hospital, the content largely concerns development and restructuring of the Forest Road facility, as well as the logistics of transferring hospital services from the Forest Road location to the Health Sciences Complex once it was ready to receive patients.

The photographs in this collection document the construction of the Health Sciences Centre and date from 1971-1977. Significant in this photograph collection are the detailed description sheets that accompany each photograph and provide important contextual information.

**Source of title:**

The title has been transferred with the collection, which was formerly series 11: Health Sciences Centre, in the collection at the LSNAM.

**Arrangement:**

When the collection was transferred to the Founders' Archive, it was already arranged into sub-series, listed below. Sub-series 11.04 and the majority of 11.05 were not included in this fonds since the material is also available in COLL-010, Health and Life Science Centre Study; COLL-011, General Hospital Development Plan; COLL-006, Dr. A.R. Cox fonds or COLL-029, Office of the Dean fonds.

## **2.0 Health Sciences Centre Construction Photographs and Descriptions, 1971-1977**

**Scope and content:** Mr. R. Harvey Self, project manager and president of Scrivener Products Newfoundland, a branch of Scrivener Products (Toronto), set up contract photographers John O'Reilly and Gordon King, who worked at Medical Audiovisual Service (MAVS) in the Faculty of Medicine, to take photographs of the construction of the Health Sciences Centre. The first photographs were taken before any construction began. The photographs include: the development of the complex; equipment; several of the many people who were involved with the project; and a number of events that took place.

The Lillian Stevenson Nursing Archives and Museum collection was formerly known as series, 14.01, Photographs. It comprises index card size description sheets containing both the titles for the photographs and corresponding negative numbers. There is also a set of numbered negatives. The title for each photograph is quite detailed, thus demonstrating clearly the progression of the construction of the Health Sciences Centre.

The description sheets, which match up with each photograph contain an original number, the month, and year each photograph was taken. There are several description sheets missing, nor are there any negatives for those gaps. The final description sheet contains the number 278 but there are only 263 photographs and titles in the collection. The photographs are digitized and available online at
