Post-doctoral Fellowship

Applications are invited for a full-time Post-Doctoral Fellowship in Centre for Rural Health Studies and Primary Healthcare Research Unit, Discipline of Family Medicine, Memorial University of Newfoundland. The position is a one year appointment starting March 1st 2017 or as soon as a qualified applicant is selected.

The successful candidate will work under the supervision of Dr. Shabnam Asghari, epidemiologist Associate Professor, Discipline of Family Medicine and Research Director, Center for Rural Health Studies.

The Post-doctoral fellow will work on projects related to rural health studies and primary healthcare. Research activities may include:

1. Developing methods to handle complex data
2. Developing and applying statistical and computational methods for the analysis of population health data.
3. Writing and publishing articles in peer-reviewed journals and submitting proposal to granting agencies
4. Communicating and collaborating with team members to initiate new projects
5. Assisting in the training and supervising of students
