

Searching the Undergraduate Medical Education Curriculum




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To access the search feature, click the fourth link in the left menu.

In the “search in” field you may select from six options:

- **Blueprint ID:** Search for sessions with learning objectives that have your specified blueprint ID
- **Course/session name:** Search for courses/sessions with names that contain your specified word/phrase
- **Course/session objective:** Search for courses/sessions with objectives that contain your specified word/phrase
- **MCC objective:** Search for sessions with related MCC objectives that contain your specified word/phrase
- **Exact MCC objective number:** Search for sessions with related MCC objectives that have your specified number
- **Program competencies:** Search for courses with related program competencies that contain your specified word/phrase

Please note that the search function treats each entered keyword separately; it does not search for phrases. For example, if you type in “heart rate” and click the Search button, the results provided will include all objectives that have the word “heart” in their descriptions and all those that have the word “rate.”
